The legal basis is § 17 Niedersächsisches Hochschulgesetz (NHG)², § 3 Niedersächsisches Datenschutzgesetz (NDSG)³, § 2 and 14 of the Act on the German National Library of Science and Technology Foundation⁴, § 5 Rules Governing the Use of the German National Library of Science and Technology⁵, in case of use of joint services across locations and institutions your consent and Art. 6 para. 1 a) EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)⁶.

When using **local services**, the partner libraries of the **Cooperation of Hannover's Scientific Libraries (HOBSY)** have access to your personal data for the provision of joint services across locations and institutions. If you order media from other libraries via interlibrary loan, your data will be transmitted to the owning library. Within the scope of **document delivery**, the libraries of the HOBSY network and owning libraries have access to your personal data only if TIB orders media for you from other libraries via interlibrary loan. If you only use **services of the TIB AV Portal** or **LUH Repository**, no data will be transmitted to other institutions. The separate registration for the use of the **All-In-One Printers** is voluntary and only required if you wish to use this service. Payment is made via chip cards with payment function for the canteens of the Studentenwerk Hannover (Studentenwerk Hannover, Jägerstraße 5, 30167 Hannover, Tel. 0511 76-88 022, <https://www.studentenwerk-hannover.de/>), to whom transaction data and card identification number are transmitted for the purpose of financial clearing.

The data will be stored for the duration of your use of the services of this library. If you no longer wish to use the library services and the library has no further claims against you for the return of media, payment of fees or any other legal reason, we will delete your data upon request. If you have not used the services of this library for more than five years, your data will be deleted.
